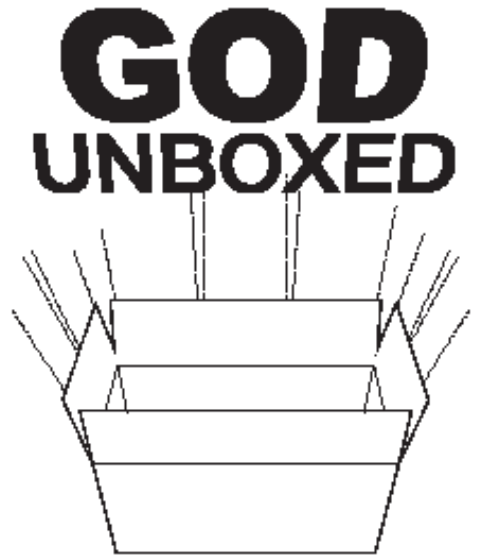
FROM THE ELDERS
