Please pray for **PHIL BAUMAN** as he flies back to Ghana today, Sunday, November 26. He is very grateful for successful cataract surgery!

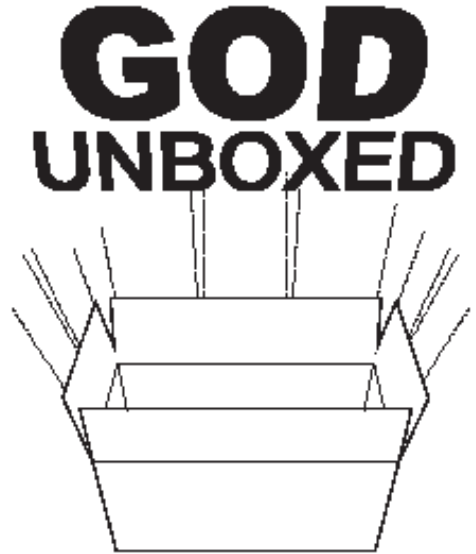
