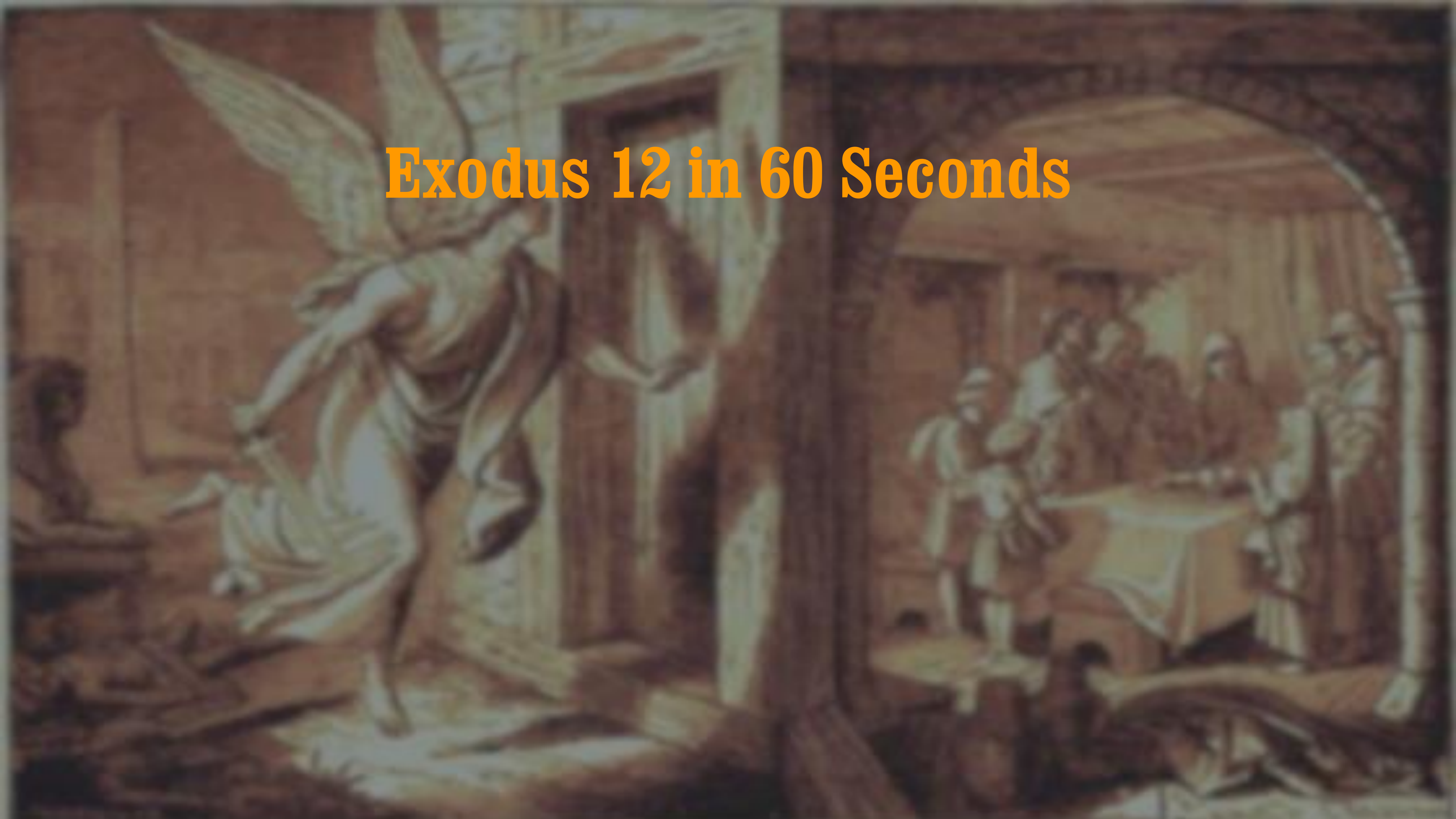
The Big Idea

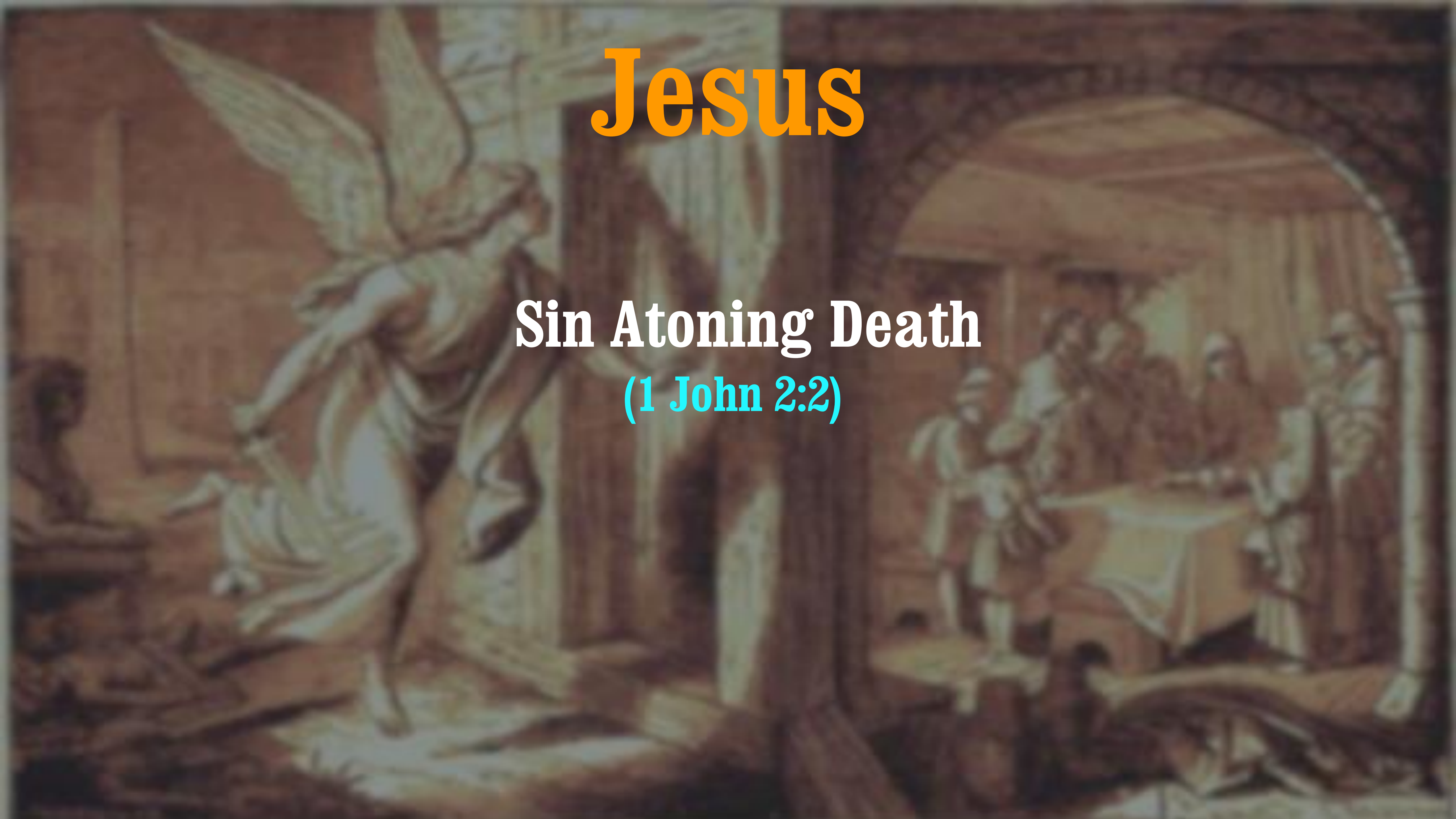

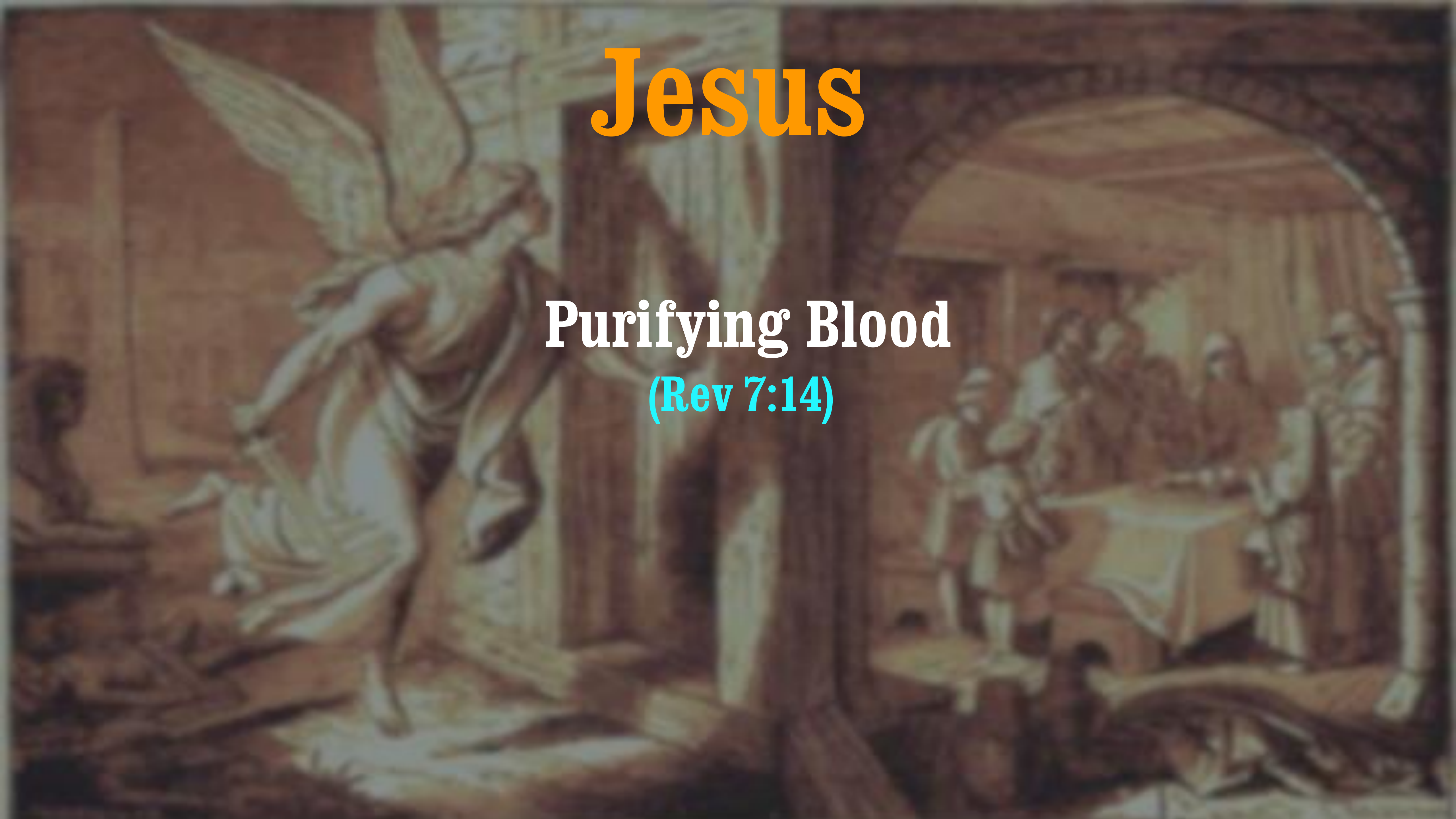

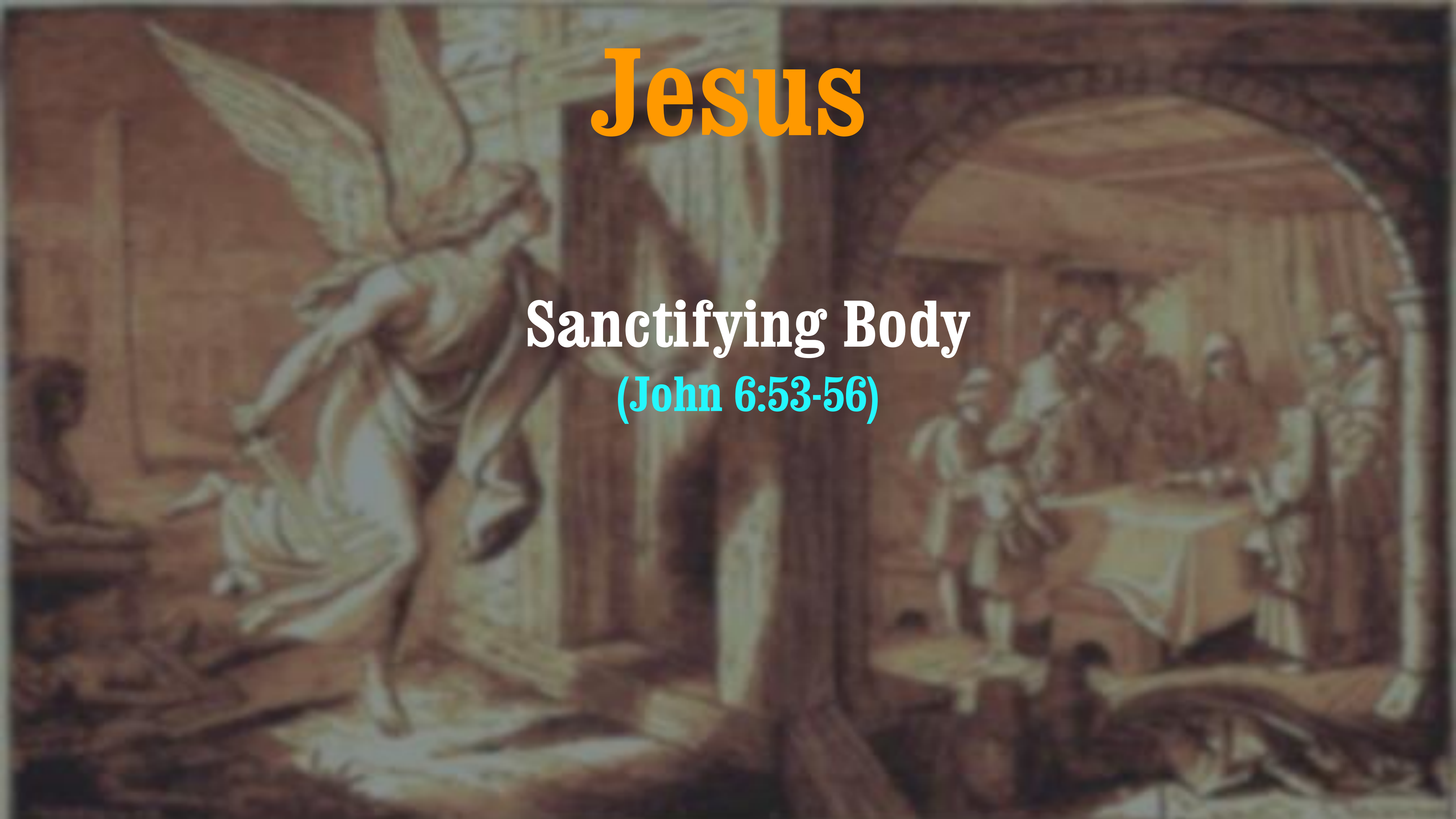
